

## 2019-2020 Dress Code

Standardized Dress will be worn at all times with the exception of days designated for special events.

Clothing Item	Styles	Colors	Special Comments
Shirts	Short or long sleeve two/three button polo-style with a collar <b>Short or long sleeve oxford-style button down with a collar</b>	<b>Solid Color; (Navy, White, or Red)</b>	If shirt has a logo it must be small and on the upper left front. Undershirts worn under shirts must be solid <b>white</b> . Oversized shirts are NOT permitted. Boys: Shirts must be tucked in at the waist. <b>Girls: Shirts/blouses may be worn out</b>
Pants and Shorts	Tailored with straight legs <b>Must have belt loops. No elastic waistbands without belts and belt loops (except for Kindergarten and first grade)</b> Appropriate length is required	Khaki/Tan or Navy Blue	Must fit at the hipbone, be hemmed, not touch the ground or be cut at the seam. Baggy or oversized styles are NOT permitted. No leggings or spandex pants allowed. Length for shorts must be no shorter than three inches above the knee.
Skirts, Skorts and Jumpers	Straight or Pleated	Khaki/Tan or Navy Blue	Length must be no shorter than three inches above the knee. Stretch and spandex are NOT permitted. Tights or leggings worn under neath need to be a solid color.
Sweatshirts, Hoodies, Sweaters, and <b>Sweater vests</b>	Long sleeve <b>unless it is a sweater vest</b> worn over an oxford-style button down shirt	<b>Grey, Navy, or Red</b>	Must be solid in color if worn throughout the day. <b>If sweatshirts, sweaters, or hoodies have a logo, it must be small and on the upper left front.</b> <b>No camouflage allowed.</b>
Coats and Jackets		<b>Grey, Navy, or Red if worn inside</b>	<b>Coats/Jackets are to be understood as outer garments that are worn outside and are to be taken off upon entering the building. Any coat/jacket that is worn inside during the day will be governed by the same rules as sweatshirts, sweaters, and hoodies.</b>
Belts			Must be worn with all pants and shorts. Boys: Must fit waist and be visible. Belt buckles may not be excessive in size.
Shoes	Must have a back or heel strap Must be tied or Velcro straps secure		Shower shoes, water shoes, flip-flops, slippers, or house shoes are NOT allowed, <b>including "Cros"</b> . No heels over one (1) inch. <b>Tennis shoes are strongly encouraged.</b>
Jewelry	Earrings: Girls may wear earrings that are not oversized or distracting.		<b>No visible body piercing or tattoos including drawing on self with markers and pens.</b> No gauging or expanding of the ears. Necklaces and bracelets must be tasteful and not excessive.
Hair and Headwear	Hair should be neatly cut and well-groomed. No facial hair is permitted.	Natural hair color	<b>No overly decorative or distracting headbands, colored ribbons, or other hair accessories.</b> <b>Hats, sweatbands, bandanas, and other head coverings are NOT allowed during the regular school day.</b>
